FESTIVAL GUIDELINES

Fiber Festival in the Valley is an indoor and outdoor Art and Artisan Festival inclusive of all fiber art and fiber art subjects. Our goal is to expose and inspire the artist and general public to create artwork through the use and education of the fiber process in traditional and non-traditional applications.

MEDIA

- All artwork must be the original handmade or created work of the artist. Reproductions of the artists own works are acceptable
- Work must be as represented in photographs submitted with the Artist Application. Work other than described or deemed offensive in nature may be subject to removal from the show.
- All work is juried by the Exhibitor Committee, and artist peer review. Exhibitors are selected on design quality and presentation.
- The number of exhibitors in each medium/design work will be limited to ensure a wide variety of art
- Vendors of supplies used in the fiber arts are eligible to participate in the festival

10 x 10 \$75 (50 available)

Guild & Demonstration Booths 10x10 Free

Only demonstrations and guilds promoting may be in these booths.

We encourage guilds, clubs, and demonstrators who would like to sell, request a double space, 1 free, 1 \$75.

Absolutely no sales allowed if a booth has not been paid for.

ENTRY & FEES Exhibitors must submit the following:

- Application - indicate 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice booth location: Indoor: 10x10 or 3x8. Outdoor: 10x10
- Photographs- four recent color photographs: 3 of artwork for the show and 1 of booth layout - to be used in the jury process and for promotional purposes if accepted.
- **NO JURY FEES**
- Applications will be accepted until May 1, 2026.

NOTE: If you participated in the Festival in the past and your work has only changed slightly, no photos needed.

ACCEPTANCE & NOTIFICATION

- Receipt of your application will be confirmed via email. Double check that your application is complete and legible.
- Acceptance letters with booth and fee amount due will be e- mailed, an electronic invoice will be sent.
- **PLEASE INDICATE ON THE APPLICATION IF YOU PREFER TO RECEIVE THE INVOICE BY SNAIL MAIL**
- Once deposited, fees will not be refunded to no-shows or withdrawals.
- You will receive your booth number at check-in. Friday set-up will be available. ***If you want your same space, PLEASE sign up by February 5th, 2026)***

Note: Once you have applied and been accepted, we will send an invoice to you. We will be accepting applications until May

SECURITY

SNCA *does not* provide any security for this event, although the Historic Gymnasium and Community Hall will be locked overnight. NO LIABILITY will be assumed by SNCA or volunteers for damage, loss or injury at any time prior, during or after the event.

INTERNET PERMISSIONS

Fiber Festival will be posting on social media and individual websites, unless checked on the application. If you do not want to have your business promoted, please indicate on your application. We respect your privacy.

FESTIVAL

- All chairs, goods, containers and supplies must be retained in the allotted space; walkways cannot be blocked
- Weights or stakes are required for outside tents and must be provided by the exhibitor
- No generators allowed.
- No loud music may be played.

CHECK-IN & SET-UP

- Check -in at Welcome Tent located at the SNCA Entrance (283 Highway 255 North) Exhibitors may set-up Friday from 1:00 pm until 6:00 pm or Saturday morning beginning at 7:00 am
- UNLOAD & MOVE your vehicle *before* beginning booth set-up. This applies both inside and outside set-up.

EXHIBITOR BREAK-DOWN

- Sunday 4:00 - 6:00 pm
- Break-down must be completed and ready to load *before* bringing vehicles to the site.
- Break-down will begin at 4:00 Sunday *No Early Breakdowns*
